- Be Ready to Board: Have your belongings ready when the bus arrives so you can hop on quickly and keep things moving for everyone.
- Keep Track of Your Ride: Utilize our helpful bus tracking tools such as the Blue Bus Tracker to monitor and plan your trip, and our Text A Bus short code found at every Blue Bus stop for bus departure times.
